With ISO certification guaranteeing PROVE Infrastructure meets global standards we hope this will only provide further credibility and trust with our clients and all stakeholders.

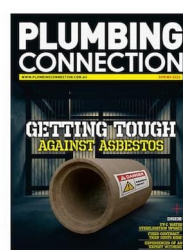

## Arc Flash:



Arc flash PPE plays an essential part in protecting electrical workers from potentially fatal injuries as a result of the light & heat created from an arc fault explosion. Despite an estimated 2,000 plus people being admitted with severe burns each year, adequate safety measures are often overlooked.

In line with PROVE's recent ISO certification and our commitment to continual improvement, we have recently invested in additional training, replaced our existing uniforms with category 2 flame retardant workwear and added category 5 coveralls, hood, gloves & boots to our available PPE stock, that will help mitigate the risks associated with the occurrences of Arc Flash.
